

2009 EVERGREEN PIECEMAKERS QUILT SHOW REGISTRATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

The deadline for registrations is to be received is April 27, 2009. The top section of your quilt Registration Form may be given to Diana Crawford or Gail Taylor at EP meetings starting any time, or you may mail or e-mail to them.

We must have all forms by the deadline in order to allow time to create and print all materials. If you think there is any chance you may have your entry finished for the show, turn in a form for it. It's a lot easier to delete an entry than to add one at the last minute.

1. We cannot accept an item on Receiving Day (Saturday, May 2, 2009) if it has not been registered.
2. All entries must be made or owned by the Evergreen Piecemakers member. You are eligible to enter the 2009 show if you have paid your 2009 dues. A quilt owned but not made by a member may be displayed but not judged.
3. Please complete a separate form for each item you enter. You may make copies of the form or get additional copies at meetings. There is no limit on the number of items you may enter in the show. There will be a limit of a total of 125 quilts to be judged. (Each member will have opportunity of entering one quilt to be judged. If there is still space available, entries will be determined on the date the registration form is received.)
4. **Please use a 4" sleeve if your quilt is over 80" wide.**
5. The challenge category is any item that exemplifies the theme of the show "New Beginnings".
6. Choose your category for each entry using the following guidelines:
 - LB - Large Bed: King or Queen – each side exceeding 80"
 - MB - Medium Bed: Ranges from Twin to Full size – at least one side exceeds 54"
 - SB - Small Bed: No side greater than 54"
 - LD - Large Duet: Made by 2 people – any side exceeds 80"
 - MD/SD - Medium/small Duet: Made by 2 people – no side exceeds 80"
 - SW - Small Wall: 100" perimeter or less
 - MW - Medium Wall: 101" to 160" perimeter
 - LW - Large Wall: Over 160" perimeter
 - G - Group: Made by 3 or more people
 - IA - Innovative/Art: Intended as a decoration or wall hanging that contains some non-traditional techniques – any size
 - W/HD – Wearables/Home Décor
 - JOU - Journal quilt: 8 ½" x 11"
 - CH - Challenge – total perimeter 100" or less (all four sides added up equals 100" or less)
 - FI - First time entry in a quilt show
 - JR - Junior (separate registration form available)
7. Submitted quilts must be cleaned of all debris such as: threads, animal hair, lint, etc. (A sticky roller does wonders!) Please air your quilt if it has been exposed to smoke.
8. Fill out both sections of the Registration Form completely and legibly. Cut off the bottom section and pin it securely to the back, lower left-hand corner of your entry using 2 safety pins (left side when looking at the back of the entry).
9. Entries will be received at Aletha Gilbreth's house, 28120 105th Avenue SE, Auburn on Saturday, May 2, 2009 from 11 AM until 7 PM. Anyone can deliver your entry. You will be given a receipt at that time, and must present that receipt in order to pick up your entry after the show.
10. Pick up your entry at Kent Commons, 525 Fourth Avenue N, Kent, WA, on Sunday, May 31, 2009 from 5 PM to 6 PM.
