

Block size (with seam allowance): **8-1/2 inches**

Suggested colors:

Use lights and darks. Make it scrappy or more controlled.

Fabric 1 Darker flowers

Fabric 2 Lighter flowers*

Fabric 3 Basket

Fabric 4 Background

*Can make scrappy by using different colors

Materials list

From fabric 1

3 ea (B) 2-7/8 inch squares for half-square triangle units

From fabric 2

4 ea (A) 2-7/8 inch squares for half-square triangle units

From fabric 3

2 ea (C-2) 2-7/8 inch squares for half-square triangle units

1 ea (C-1) 2-1/2 inch square

From fabric 4

2 ea (D-3) 2-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch rectangles

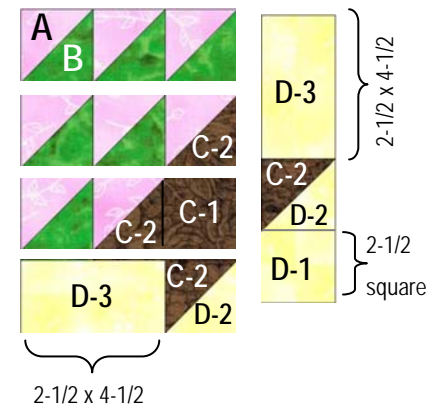
1 ea (D-2) 2-7/8 inch square for half-square triangle units

1 ea (D-1) 2-1/2 inch square

Directions

For piecing:

1. Flower units: Using three of the "A" squares and three of the "B" squares, make six half-square triangle units as show on the right.
2. Basket units: Using one of the "C-2" squares and one of the "A" squares, make two half-square triangle units as shown on the right. Then take one of the "C-2" squares and one of the "D-2" squares to make two half-square triangle units for the base of the basket.
3. Using the diagram as a guide, assemble the units to make the Basket block.



Half-Square Triangles:

1. Place two squares of contrasting colors, right sides together, matching raw edges.
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
3. Stitch 1/4 inch on both sides of diagonal line.
4. Cut apart on drawn line.
5. Open and press seam towards dark fabric.
