

Block size (with seam allowance): 8-1/2 inches

Can you just imagine looking at a stained glass window and seeing the beautiful light streaming through. This block evokes that stunning image.

Suggested colors:

Use three different fabrics: Choose from blues, purples, or lavenders then use a light fabric for the "window".

Fabric 1 Darkest

Fabric 2 Medium or contrasting with fabric 1

Fabric 3 Lightest for the window

Materials list

From fabric 1:

2 ea (B) 4-1/2 inch squares

4 ea (C) 2-1/2 inch squares

From fabric 2:

8 ea (A) 2-1/2 inch squares

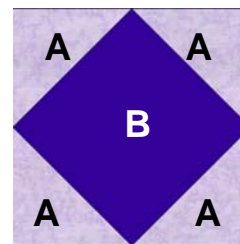
From fabric 3:

2 ea (D) 4-1/2 inch squares

Directions

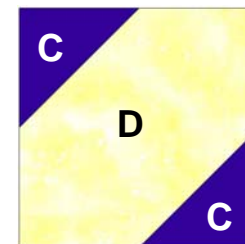
For piecing:

Make units using the sew-and-flip method. You'll notice Unit 2 has only two sew-and-flip half-square triangles set in opposite corners. After completion of the units, stitch together using the block diagram as a guideline.

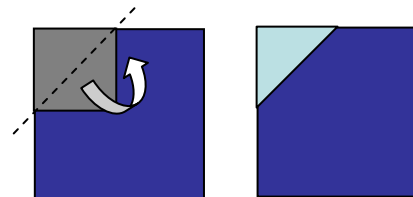

Sew-and-Flip:

To make Unit 1 above, place a 2-1/2 inch "A" square in the upper left-hand corner of a 4-1/2 inch "B" square, right sides together matching raw edges as shown in the diagram below. Diagonally stitch corner to corner on the smaller square. Flip up the lower triangle of the small square to reveal a "half-square" triangle. Repeat the process for the other three corners. Use the same process for Unit 2 above where just two half-square triangles are used.



Flip smaller square up to get this →
