

Block size (with seam allowance): 12-1/2 inches

**Suggested colors:**

Use red, white and blue colors:

- Fabric 1 Red
- Fabric 2 White
- Fabric 3 Blue

**Materials list**

**From fabric 1:**

- 2 ea (A-1) 4-7/8 inch squares
- 8 ea (A-2) 2-1/2 inch squares

**From fabric 2:**

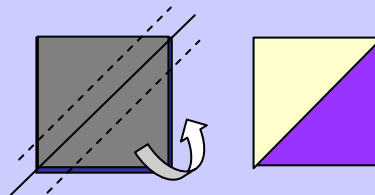
- 2 ea (B-1) 4-7/8 inch squares
- 4 ea (B-2) 2-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch rectangles
- 1 ea (B-3) 4-1/2 inch square

**From fabric 3:**

- 4 ea (C) 2-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch rectangles

**Half-Square Triangles:**

1. Place a white 4-7/8 inch square (B-1) on top of a red 4-7/8 inch square (A-1), right sides together, matching raw edges.
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
3. Stitch 1/4 inch on both sides of diagonal line.
4. Cut along diagonal line.
5. Open and press seam towards dark fabric.



**Directions**

**For piecing:**

1. Using the red and white fabrics, make four half-square triangle units as shown below.
2. Use sew-and-flip method to attach A-2 to C-1.
3. Using the diagram as a reference, stitch the units into rows then stitch the rows together to make the block.
