

Block size (with seam allowance): 9-1/2 inches

Leaves are such a beautiful gift from Mother Nature, from the first new growth of Spring to the incredible flaming colors of Fall.

Suggested colors:

Use any leaf color and use a lighter color for the background.

Fabric 1 Background color

Fabric 2 Leaf color

Fabric 3 Stem green

Materials list

From fabric 1:

- 1 ea (A) 3-1/2 inch square for background
- 2 ea (B) 3-7/8 inch squares for background
- 2 ea (F) 3-inch squares for background

From fabric 2:

- 2 ea (C) 3-7/8 inch squares for leaf
- 3 ea (D) 3-1/2 inch squares center of leaf

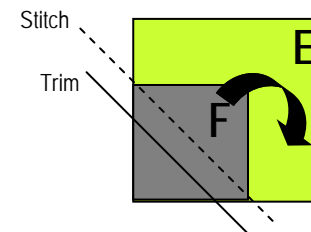
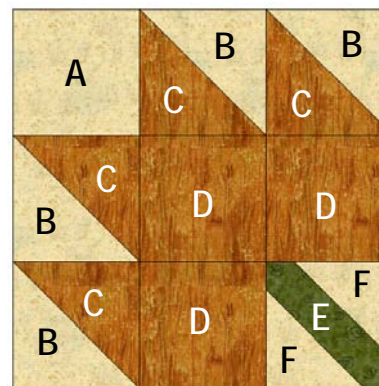
From fabric 3:

- 1 ea (E) 3-1/2 inch square for stem

Directions

For piecing

1. Place a 3-7/8 inch "B" background square right sides together on top of a "C" Leaf 3-7/8 inch square.
2. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner.
3. Stitch 1/4 inch on both sides of the drawn line.
4. Cut on the drawn line to get two half-square triangles.
5. Repeat with the other 3-7/8 inch leaf square and background fabric.
6. Use the sew-and-flip method to make the stem unit.
 1. Place a 3-inch "F" background square right sides together in the lower left-hand corner of the "E" 3-1/2 inch square, matching raw edges.
 2. Draw a diagonal line on the "F" square as shown in the diagram below.
 3. Stitch on the line.
 4. Press open towards the lower left corner.
 5. Repeat for the upper right corner of the unit.
7. Stitch units together as shown in the diagram below.





Directions

For appliqué:

1. Center the oak leaf wreath on a 11-1/2 inch background fabric.
2. Use an appliqué method of your choice. If fused, finish the edges with a buttonhole stitch, narrow zig-zag or any decorative stitch.
3. After appliqué is complete, trim the block to a 10-1/2 inch square.

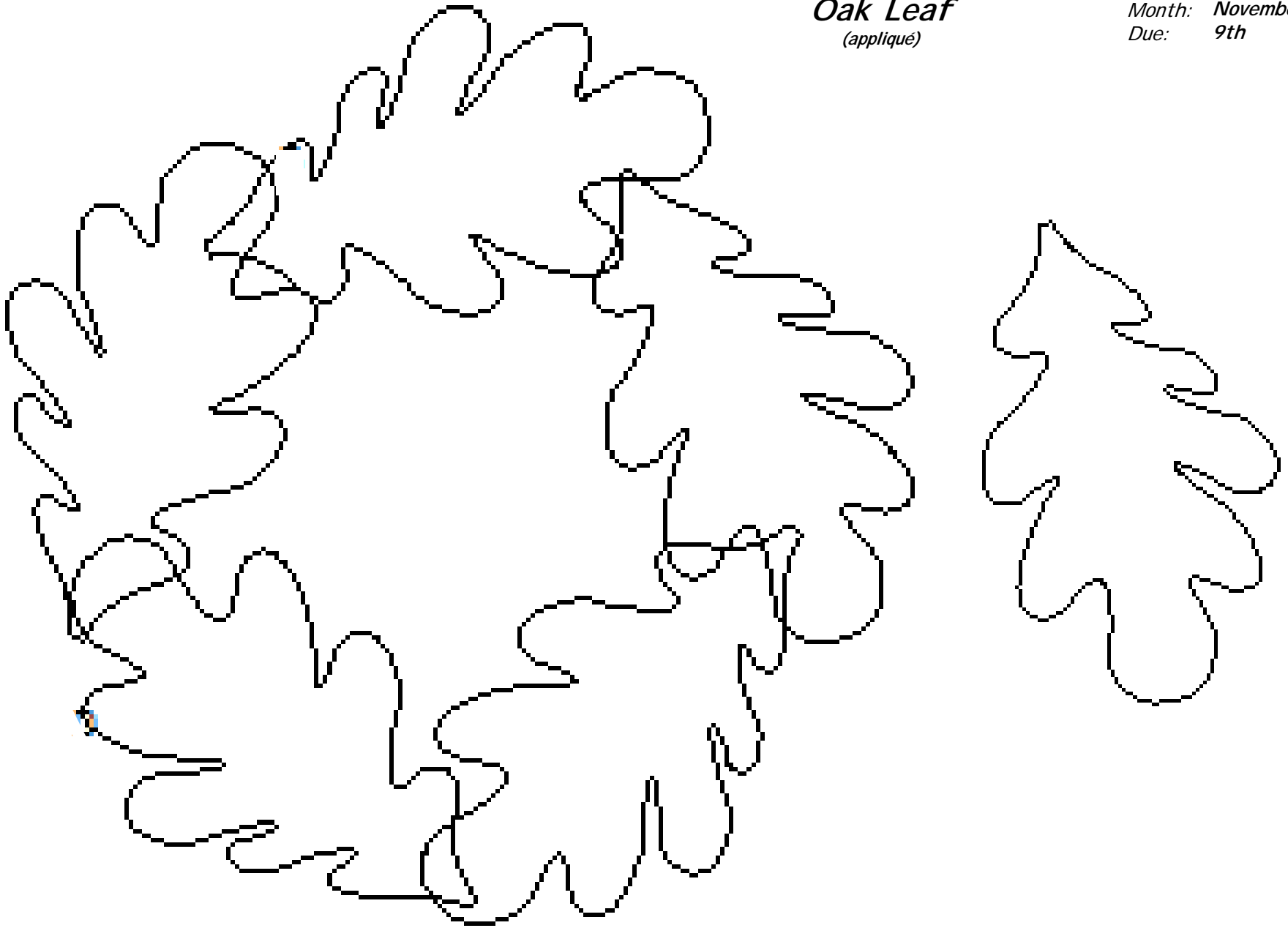
